

THIS IS A GRADE II* LISTED BUILDING

THIS WAS THE FORMER RECTORY BUILT IN 1726NEXT TO THE CHURCH IN LAMPORT FORMING AN UNUSUAL TRILOGY OF NEIGHBOURING BUILDINGS WITH CHURCH & HALL.

THE PROPERTY CONSISTS OF TWO PADDOCKS WITH AN ATTRACTIVE GARDEN THAT LOOKS OUT OVER THE VALLEY OF THE RIVER NENE.

IT IS A THREE-STOREY MANSION IN GEORGIAN STYLE IN LOCAL STONE DESIGNED BY FRANCIS SMITH OF WARWICK FOR THE REVEREND EUSEBY ISHAM, VICAR OF LAMPORT CHURCH.

IT CONTAINS NINE BEDROOMS, FOUR BATHROOMS, TWO RECEPTION ROOMS, DINING ROOM, STUDY, LARGE HALL WITH A GRAND SWEEPING STAIRCASE.
